Thurston, L., 1973 **Chemical Treatment** of Cadgeroad Lake

- Pronoxfish applied to the lake – 34 gallons
- 89 Yellow Perch, 263 Creek Chub, 14 Iowa Darters & 1 White Sucker captured dead
- Population Estimates: Yellow Perch 1,313, Creek Chub 34,532 & Darter 1,838
- Author notes a probable oxygen problem during ice-over
