#### **1986 Trapnet Survey**

Trapnet catches; Northern Pike – 96, Largemouth Bass – 84, Bowfin – 50, Pumpkinseed – 292, Yellow Perch – 23, Brown Bullhead – 1,534, Black Crappie – 410 & Golden Shiner - 2

1983 Inland Lake Assessment – Cranberry Lake

- No largemouth bass from the 1979 planting were captured.
- Eight largemouth bass captured does represent some natural reproduction.
- Information gathered indicates the establishment of a self-sustaining largemouth bass fishery has failed.

#### Baldwin, R.W. 1980 Largemouth Bass Transfers & Introductions 1979

• 238 adult and sub-adult largemouth bass transferred from Yarrow(91), Windfall(61), Nevelle(34) and Brennan(52) Lakes

Baldwin, R.W. 1980 Coarse Fish Removal From Inland Lakes During 1978 & 1979

- 1978 coarse fish removal; 1,500 Brown Bullhead
- 1979 coarse fish removal; 3.197 Brown Bullhead & 45 Bowfin

Thurston, L.D.W. 1978 Comparison of Eight Bass Fisheries

- Excellent largemouth bass habitat exists but few bass were found.
- Speculates the large number of brown bullheads is directly competing with bass.
