Summary of Fisheries Studies / Reports:

Sober, L. 1988 Galla Lake Trap-net Results

- Trap netting utilizing four and six foot trap nets.
- Catch per unit Effort for Smallmouth Bass was 2.28 ±2.13.
- Catch per unit Effort for Largemouth Bass was 1.50 ± 1.14 .
- The C.U.E. is low compared to other district lakes possibly due to lack of habitat.
- The littoral zone is restricted close to the shoreline due to a quick drop in depth.

• Under a C.F.I.P. between 1984 and 1988 59 tied bundles of brush were placed to provide protection for bass fry and 15 rock ring bass spawning beds were created.
