• 45 largemouth bass trapped and transferred to Santa Lake (Christie Twp.)

MNR 1981 General Assessment

- 9 largemouth bass transferred to Fume Lake (Christie Twp.)
- 21 brown bullhead were removed

Thurston, L. 1978 Comparison of Eight Bass Fisheries In The Parry Sound Forest District

- Reproduction is excellent for largemouth bass.
- Older age classes are underrepresented suggesting overexploitation. The removal of adults for transfer would have contributed.
- Report indicates in 1976 a total of 219 adult largemouth bass were removed and transferred

MNR 1978 General Assessment

• A total of 251 adult largemouth bass transferred to district lakes.

Management Prescription:

Manage as naturalized, self-sustaining smallmouth and largemouth bass fishery.
